The VigorC510 series is a 5G NR WAN router equipped with four 1Gbps LAN ports. It features an advanced bandwidth control mechanism, including IP-layer control, QoS, NAT session limitation, and bandwidth borrowing, to enable easy, flexible, and reliable access control and bandwidth management.

New Features

Improvement

- Improved: Display ICCID & IMEI information when WAN is offline.
- Improved: Cellular bandwidth limit for both Tx/Rx can be applied correctly.
- Improved: Add a new feature, iPerf as the WAN Test tool on Utility>>Network Tools.
- Improved: Improve LTE/5G-NR connection stability by handling duplicated processes.
- Improved: Apply the bandwidth limitation to each source IP on IAM>>Hotspot Web Portal.
- Improved: Add options related to Privacy Policy & Terms and Conditions, on IAM>>Hotspot Web Portal.
- Corrected: An issue with the LTE module not coming online when SIM PIN was set.
- Corrected: An issue with failure to get the system uptime and name via SNMP server.
- Corrected: An issue with failure to apply the DHCP option number 60 for a virtual WAN.
- Corrected: An issue with failing to connect to the WiFi, even though the SSID has been detected.
- Corrected: An issue with incorrect display when WAN DNS was set to Manual on the WAN interface.
